

## Getting to Know Our Great God in Exodus 1-17

**Intro:** In Exodus chapters 1-17, God reveals himself to Moses, Israel, Pharaoh, and the Egyptians in extraordinary ways.

- I. The God who remembers his people: Ex. 2:23-25
  - a. To “remember” means to act on another’s behalf
  - b. God planned it 400 years in advance: Gen. 15:12-14
  
- II. The God who calls: Ex 3:1-12
  - a. He calls Moses by name
  - b. He promises his presence
  
- III. The God who gives us his name: Ex 3:13-15
  - a. To Moses: “I AM WHO I AM”: יהוה יהוה *Yahweh*
  - b. To Abraham: “God Almighty”: אֱלֹהֵי שַׁדַּי *El Shaddai*
  
- IV. The God who is God
  - a. Miraculous signs for Moses: Ex 4:1-9
  - b. Miraculous signs for the people of Israel: Ex 4:29-31
  - c. Miraculous signs for Pharaoh: Ex 7:8-13
  
- V. The God who judges and saves: Ex 7:2-5
  - a. The first nine plagues: Ex 7:14-10:29
  - b. The 10<sup>th</sup> plague & the Passover: Ex 11:1-12:30
  
- VI. The God who leads and protects: Ex 13:18; 14:19-24
  - a. In a pillar of fire and cloud: Ex 13:21-22
  - b. Giving light, watching over, fighting for his people
  
- VII. The God who provides
  - a. Manna & meat: Ex 16:4, 8, 10-15
  - b. Water: Ex 17:3-6
