 - a. Not kings, and maybe not three, but they were wise
 - b. They speak one line, and they ask one question: Where?
 - c. Their journey had one purpose: "to worship him."
- III. "Prayer and praising, all men raising, Worship Him, God on high."
 - a. They were overjoyed when they found Jesus
 - b. They bowed down and worshiped him
 - c. They opened their treasures and presented him with gifts
