

“The Seven C’s of Jonah 3”

Jonah 3:1-10

Intro: When did you first hear the message of God?
What did God say to you? How did you respond?

I. Content

- a. The LORD tells Jonah a second time to go to Nineveh and proclaim his message. Jonah obeys. The Ninevites believe God and repent. The LORD relents.

II. Context

- a. The world’s shortest sermon and greatest revival?

III. Commands

- a. The LORD tells Jonah where to go and what to say

IV. Corollaries

- a. 2 Chronicles 34 (Josiah) and Acts 2 (Pentecost)

V. Comfort

- a. Our greatest comfort comes through Christ’s suffering
- b. God turned his fierce anger from Nineveh to the cross

VI. Curiosities

- a. Animals fasting and covered with sackcloth?
- b. Who was the king of Nineveh?
- c. How long did the revival last?

VII. Christ (Matthew 12:38-41)

- a. Jesus preaches a greater message than Jonah
- b. Jesus saves greater than the huge fish saved Jonah
