 - a. Where is your treasure? Matthew 6:21

 - a. “We love because he first loved us” 1 John 4:19
 - b. Jesus loves me and gave himself for me. Gal. 2:20
 - c. The LORD will circumcise your heart so that you may love him with all your heart. Deuteronomy 30:6
