- I. The Drive – *What drives you on your journey?*
 - a. On the Highway
 - i. Deception
 - ii. Desire
 - iii. Destruction
 - b. On the Footpath
 - i. Faith
 - ii. Obedience

- II. The Direction – *Who are you following?*
 - a. Down the Highway
 - i. The beast (*disguised*: disguised misguidance)
 - ii. The world (spiritually complacent)
 - iii. The dragon (rebellious)
 - b. Along the Footpath
 - i. He calls his sheep by name and leads them
 - ii. “The Lord is my shepherd...”

- III. The Destination – *Where will you spend eternity?*
 - a. In Hell
 - i. Suffering fire and brimstone
 - ii. Relentlessly restless
 - b. In Heaven
 - i. Worshiping the Lamb before the throne
 - ii. Enjoying Sabbath rest
