## The Big IFs of the Resurrection

## 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, 12-20

- "IF this report gets to the governor..." Matthew 28:14
- I. IF you hold firmly to the word, you are saved (1 Cor. 15:2)
  - a. Most significant prepositional phrase: for our sins
  - b. Most significant tomb: he was buried
  - c. Most significant day: he was raised on the third day
- II. IF there is no resurrection of the dead...
  - a. (No what? What is the resurrection at the last day?)\*
  - b. ...then Christ has not been raised, and...
  - c. ...faith is futile, preaching is useless, and we are lost!
- III. BUT Christ has indeed been raised from the dead!
  - a. Firstfruits of the resurrection (here's that connection)\*
  - b. Validates everything Jesus said and did—therefore...
  - c. ...faith in Christ is fruitful, and hope in Christ is living

"IF you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Romans 10:9 (NIV, bold and capitalization added)
