Ephesians 1:18-20

- In Ephesians 1:17, Paul prays that God would give believers the Spirit of revelation.
 - In Ephesians 1:18, Paul prays that God would enlighten believers’ hearts to see His revelation.
1. That the eyes of your heart may be enlightened
 - a. Eyes: *ophthalmos* – organ/ability to see
 - b. Heart: *kardia* – center of feelings, intellect, and will
 - c. Enlightened: *photizo* – light up, illumine, make evident

 - iii. 2 Corinthians 4:3-6
 - iv. Romans 10:9-10
 2. In order that you may know:
 - a. The hope to which God has called you
 - i. Help – Psalm 46:1
 - ii. Overcome: John 16:33
 - iii. Peace: John 16:33
 - iv. Encouragement: Psalm 23
 - b. The riches of God’s glorious inheritance
 - c. God’s incomparably great power for us who believe
 - i. Romans 1:16
 - ii. 1 Corinthians 1:18
