

## “The LUNGS of the Gospel”

### Ephesians 1:19b-23

- What comes to mind when you think about God’s “incomparably great power”?
  - Every time someone references the calendar year they attest to Jesus’s resurrection from the dead!
1. **L**iving & Breathing!
    - a. Jesus breathed his last on the cross (Luke 23:46)
    - b. 2 1/2 days later, He breathed on his disciples!
    - c. Gospel CPR: Check for breathing
  2. **U**p from the grave He arose!
    - a. *With a mighty triumph o’er His foes...and He lives forever*
    - b. *I serve a risen Savior...I know that He is living*
    - c. *You ask me how I know He lives? He lives within my heart!*
  3. **N**ever to die again
    - a. Not returned or resuscitated but resurrected
    - b. Triumphed over death: Romans 6:9
    - c. Christ gives us victory over death! 1 Cor. 15:57
  4. **G**od’s glory
    - a. A glimpse with Lazarus: John 11:4, 40
    - b. At the last trumpet: 1 Cor. 15:50-54
  5. **S**alvation
    - a. The heart of the Gospel: 1 Cor. 1:18
    - b. The lungs of the Gospel: Romans 10:9
